

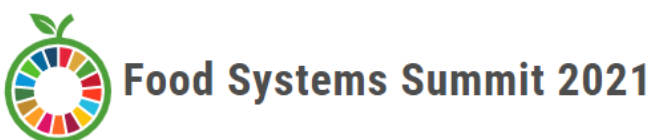
Declaration of 2030 Commitment to Sustainable Raw Materials Procurement and Environmental Burden Reduction at the 2021 UN Food Systems Summit

At the UN Food Systems Summit 2021 to be held in New York, USA, in September this year, Fuji Oil Holdings Inc. (Osaka, President & CEO: Mikio Sakai) will commit to the sustainable procurement of raw materials and to goals for 2030 that include reducing CO2 emissions, water usage, and waste, and will declare its intent to contribute to reforms aiming for sustainability in food systems.

The Food Systems Summit is an event held by the UN on the basis of Secretary-General António Guterres' belief that transitioning to sustainable food systems* is imperative in order to achieve the SDGs. The first such international summit of its kind, it will be attended by high-level representatives from each country and will provide the venue for a debate from a systemic perspective on ensuring sustainability in food as a global issue, and will set out the ideal form that these systems should take.

As well as governmental representatives, this summit will be attended by a range of stakeholders in food systems (producers, companies, consumers, and others), and each country will outline and submit the initiatives that they will commit to with the aim of putting in place sustainable food systems.

Fuji Oil Group concurs with the aims of this summit, and as part of the commitment to be made by the Japanese government we will set the following goals and aim to create food systems that facilitate abundance and health for the planet and people, and will push forward our PBFS (Plant-Based Food Solutions).
